Available form: 100g of powder sample, grain size less than 0,2 mm.

Intended use: This Reference Material is intended for use in determination of chemical composition of iron ores by x-ray fluorescence spectrometry, UV-Vis spectrometry, AAS, ICP-AES and C,S-analyzers and other wet methods. Chemical analyses should be carried out on samples dried at 105°C.

Validity of certification: The certification of IMZ3.55 is valid for 15 years - until December 2033, within the uncertainty specified provided this Reference Material is stored in accordance with the instructions given in this certificate (see Storage). The certification is nullified if this Reference Material is damaged, contaminated or otherwise modified.
