

STATEMENT OF CONSENT TO USE IMAGE

The following statement concerns the consent to the free of charge recording of the image (including voice), for the purpose of its possible publication and distribution in informational, promotional, educational, marketing materials related to the event, by Łukasiewicz Research Network – Upper Silesian Institute of Technology, other Institutes of the Łukasiewicz Research Network, and event co-organizers.

The Personal Data Controller, including image data, is Łukasiewicz Research Network – Upper Silesian Institute of Technology (hereinafter referred to as "**Łukasiewicz – GIT**"), with its registered office in Poland, at ul. Karola Miarki 12–14, 44-100 Gliwice, POLAND.

I, the undersigned, based on Article 81(1) of the Act of February 4, 1994, on Copyright and Related Rights (consolidated text Journal of Laws of 2021, item 1062), and Article 6(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR"),

YES, I voluntarily and free of charge give consent to the recording of my image (including voice) in the form of e.g. photos, audio-video recordings, online broadcasts via the Internet, etc., made during (**name of the event**) organized on at (**name and/or address of the venue**) (hereinafter referred to as "**the event**") and to the possible publication by the Controller of my image, without time or territorial limitations, in the form of audiovisual materials (works) on the website and social media profiles of Łukasiewicz – GIT and other Institutes of the Łukasiewicz Research Network and co-organizers of the event, as well as their possible dissemination in the form of press and television publications, exclusively for informational, promotional, educational, and marketing purposes related to the event. The Controller ensures that the above audiovisual materials (works) will not violate my personal rights or the rights of third parties and will not be published in forms generally considered offensive or unethical.

NO, I do not give consent to the recording of my image (including voice) in the form of e.g. photos, audio-video recordings, online broadcasts via the Internet, etc., made during the event, nor to their publication by the Controller in the form of audiovisual materials (works) with my direct participation.

At the same time, I acknowledge that:

- giving consent to the recording of my image (including voice) during the event and to the possible publication and dissemination by the Controller of my image, in the form of audiovisual materials (works) for informational, promotional, educational, and marketing purposes related to the event is entirely voluntary. Refusal to give consent to the recording and publication and dissemination of my image will have no impact on my participation in the event. The consequence of not giving consent will be the cessation of taking photos, audio-video recordings, online broadcasts via the Internet with my direct participation during the event and the deletion of already taken photos and recorded audiovisual materials (works) with my direct participation.
- The Controller will process my image data until the above purposes cease or until I withdraw the consent I voluntarily gave. This consent may be withdrawn at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Consent can be withdrawn by sending a message about the withdrawal to the email address: sekretariat@git.lukasiewicz.gov.pl. Withdrawal of consent obliges the Controller to cease publication and delete my data, including image data and audiovisual materials (works) with my direct participation from the websites and social media profiles belonging to Łukasiewicz – GIT and other Institutes of the Łukasiewicz Research Network and co-organizers of the event.

Information Clause:

1. **The Controller of your personal data is Łukasiewicz Research Network – Upper Silesian Institute of Technology** (hereinafter referred to as "**Łukasiewicz – GIT**"), with its registered office in Poland. 3. **Legal basis and purposes of processing your personal data:**
 - a) Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR and Article 81(1) of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights – based on your freely given, unpaid consent to the recording of your image (including voice) in the form of e.g. photos, audio-video recordings, online broadcasts, etc., during the event, and to the potential publication by the Controller of your image, without time or territorial limitations, in the form of audiovisual materials (works) on the

website and social media profiles of Łukasiewicz – GIT and other Institutes of the Łukasiewicz Research Network and co-organizers of the event, and their possible dissemination in the form of press and TV publications, solely for informational, promotional, educational, and marketing purposes related to the event. You may withdraw this consent at any time by sending information about the withdrawal to the e-mail address: sekretariat@git.lukasiewicz.gov.pl. Refusal to consent will not affect your application or participation in the event. The result of refusing consent will be the cessation of recording and the deletion of previously recorded audiovisual materials with your direct participation.

- b) Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR – processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject and Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR – processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest, in accordance with Articles 1(2), 2(2), 3(2), and 4 of the Act of 21 February 2019 on the Łukasiewicz Research Network and the Act of 6 September 2001 on access to public information, unless the information is protected by confidentiality or privacy.
 - c) Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or by a third party, i.e., to retention of documentation for evidentiary purposes for the period resulting from the limitation periods for claims; to conduct information, marketing activities, including the evaluation of services provided, satisfaction surveys, etc., to which you may lodge an objection with the Controller at any time.
4. Recipients or categories of recipients of your personal data – your personal data, including image data, may be shared with entities providing services to the Controller (e.g.: digital media processing, publication production, website and social media management, press publishers, TV broadcasters, other Łukasiewicz Institutes, event co-organizers, etc.), ensuring full data protection through appropriate agreements. Also, supervisory authorities, superior units, and public bodies entitled under applicable laws may receive your data.
 5. Your personal data will generally not be transferred outside the European Economic Area, except where the Controller uses Microsoft 365 or services like YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, Messenger, X.com (Twitter), which may result in data being processed outside the EEA under standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission.
 6. Your personal data will be processed until the above purposes are fulfilled or until you withdraw your consent. Your data will be stored until the limitation period for claims under applicable laws (e.g. Civil Code Article 118), and for archiving purposes under the Act of 14 July 1983 on the national archival resource and archives, and internal regulations of Łukasiewicz – GIT. After these periods, your data will be deleted.

Your rights:

7. You have the right, under Articles 15–20 of the GDPR, to request from the Controller: access to your data, rectification, erasure ("right to be forgotten"), restriction of processing, and data portability.
8. You have the right, under Article 21(1) of the GDPR, to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to processing based on the Controller's or third party's legitimate interests (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).
9. You have the right, under Article 7(3) of the GDPR, to withdraw your consent at any time if the processing is based on your freely given consent under Article 6(1)(a) or 9(2)(a) of the GDPR. In case of image consent withdrawal, it obliges the Controller to stop publication and remove your image and audiovisual materials from all related websites and profiles. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority i.e., President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland, by telephone: (+48) 22 531 03 00, by email: <https://uodo.gov.pl/pl/p/kontakt> or by letter at the address: Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych, ul. Stanisława Moniuszki 1A, 00-014 Warszawa, POLAND, if you consider that the Controller's processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
